



How to Map Supplier Destination Values

When working with online suppliers, it is necessary to match the destination values in the supplier's database with those already defined in the Travel Booster local database.

This document will describe how to map a supplier's destination values to the local Travel Booster database destination values.

This document is intended for Travel Booster users who are familiar with the Setup menus and know how to define a new supplier.

Match destinations

Mapping table for online supplier in Administration Tools

1 Login to Administration Tools.

2 Go to **Setup ► Supplier Accounts ► [Supplier Name]**

3 Open the **Online Supplier** expander.

4 Verify that the **Active** option is selected.

5 Press **Click [Here](#) to update interface properties.**

Note that the fields in this dialog window may differ according to the online supplier (CRS interface) selected.

Verify that the connection details in the dialog window are valid.

6 Click **Match destinations** to import the supplier's destination values.


A table will be displayed, presenting the destination values in the local database and those in the supplier's database.

A supplier destination value with a corresponding **identical** local destination value **will be automatically matched** and the two values will appear on the same row in the table. Rows with unmatched values will appear at the beginning of the table, followed by the matched values.

7 The **unmatched** supplier destination values **relevant to products in your system** need to be mapped.


7a Click  by the supplier destination value to **automatically add the supplier destination value** to the local database and create a match between the supplier value and the local value.

7b Click  by the supplier destination value to **manually map the supplier destination value** to the local database. After clicking the pencil icon, a drop-down list of local database destinations will be displayed. Select the relevant local database entry to match the supplier value.
Click  to save the entry or  to revert.


7c To map the supplier destination value to more than one value in the local database, click  and then select **Multiple mapping** from the pop-up menu that is displayed:

Multiple mapping
Add sub destination

A multi-selection list which includes all the local destination values will be displayed. Click the destination values in the **Not Selected** list to map to the supplier destination value. These values will be displayed in the **Selected** list.

Click  to complete the mapping.

7d After completing the matching process, click .

8 To unmap a supplier destination value to a value in the local database, click  and then select **Clear mapping** from the pop-up menu that is displayed:
